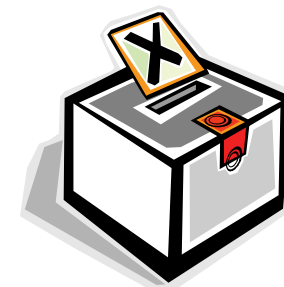

3. Residence Address in Cleveland County
4. Mailing address where ballot is to be mailed
5. Sign Letter of Request and place birth date under signature.

### **LETTER OF REQUEST BY NEAR RELATIVE:**

Follow same procedure as above (1-5), and include:

6. The relationship of the near relative to the person to whom the ballot will be mailed.
7. Plus the contact information for the near relative.

### **NEAR RELATIVES ARE:**

Spouse, brother, sister, parent, child, grandparent, grandchild, mother-in-law, father-in-law, daughter-in-law, son-in-law, stepparent, or stepchild.

### **DEADLINES FOR ABSENTEE VOTING BY MAIL:**

**2010 Primary Elections: May 4, 2010**

1. March 15-April 27, 2010 letter of requests are accepted and ballots are mailed by the Board of Elections Office
2. April 27-May 3, 2010 letter of requests are accepted for sick and disabled voters ONLY by the Board of Elections Office
3. Ballots must be returned by May 3, 2010 at 5:00 P.M. or be POSTMARKED by May 4, 2010 and received by mail no later than 5:00 P.M. on May 7, 2010.

**2010 2nd Primary Elections: June 22, 2010**

1. June 3-June 15, 2010 letter of requests are accepted and ballots are mailed by the Board of Elections Office
2. June 15-June 21, 2010 letter of requests are accepted for sick and disabled voters ONLY by the Board of Elections Office
3. Ballots must be returned by June 21, 2010 at 5:00 P.M. or be POSTMARKED by June 22, 2010 and received by mail no later than 5:00 P.M. on June 25, 2010.

**2010 General Election: November 2, 2010**

1. Sept. 6-October 26, 2010 letter of requests are accepted and ballots are mailed by the Board of Elections Office
2. October 26-November 1, 2010 letter of requests are accepted for sick and disabled voters ONLY by the Board of Elections Office
3. Ballots must be returned by November 1, 2010 at 5:00 P.M. or be POSTMARKED by November 2, 2010 and received by mail no later than 5:00 P.M. on November 5, 2010.
