## **Drug Classes:**

### **Maintenance Medications:**

- Spiriva (tiotropium bromide) - long-acting anticholinergic
- Foradil (formoterol) – long-acting B<sub>2</sub> agonist
- Serevent (salmeterol) – long-acting B<sub>2</sub> agonist
- Pulmicort (budesonide) – inhaled corticosteroid
- QVAR (beclomethasone) – inhaled corticosteroid
- Aerobid (flunisolide) – inhaled corticosteroid
- Azmacort (triamcinolone) – inhaled corticosteroid
- Theophylline – oral methylxanthines
- Advair (salmeterol + fluticasone) – combination long-acting B<sub>2</sub> agonist + corticosteroid

### **Rescue Medications:**

- Atrovent (ipratropium bromide) – short-acting anticholinergic
- Albuterol – short-acting B<sub>2</sub> agonist
- Maxair (pirbuterol) – short-acting B<sub>2</sub> agonist
- Combivent (albuterol + Atrovent) – combination

### **Nebulizer:**

- Ventolin, Proventil (Albuterol) – short-acting B<sub>2</sub> agonist
- Accuneb (Albuterol) – short-acting B<sub>2</sub> agonist
- Xopenex (levalbuterol) – short-acting B<sub>2</sub> agonist
- Duoneb (Albuterol + ipratropium) – combination short-acting B<sub>2</sub> agonist + anticholinergic
- Pulmicort respules (budesonide) – corticosteroid
