### **PUBLIC HEARING; ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVES FOR PROJECT X-CEL**

County Manager Eddie Bailes reviewed details of the incentive agreement between Cleveland County and Project X-Cel (*copy found on Page \_\_\_\_\_ of Minute Book \_\_\_\_\_*).

Chairman Hawkins opened the public hearing (notice of this hearing was accomplished in accordance with the General Statutes in <u>The Shelby Star</u> on January 19, 2013).

#### David Dear, representative of Cleveland County Economic Development Partnership, spoke in

support of the project. Project X-Cel is a market leader in metal parts for the automotive industry. Mr. Dear and Kristin Fletcher visited two of their plants in Europe and were very impressed. "This is a company that anyone in America would love to have in their community." Mr. Dear thanked Commissioners for all they have done regarding economic development. "Lots of people have been put to work through your efforts."

<u>Martina Clark</u>, asked if something would be done to track the \$500,000 that the county would be getting from the NCDOT for construction of the access road to serve Project X-Cel. She claimed she was a member of Eskridge Grove Baptist Church. Ms. Clark was concerned with whether or not this project would affect the church. She spoke in support of the project but again voiced her concern about how this may encroach on the constitutional rights of the church.

Michael Chrisawn, 107 Cameron Drive Kings Mountain, on behalf of the 630 Chamber members,

spoke in support of the project. He said this would diversify the economic base and create jobs. "2012 was

great. 2013 is opening just as positive."

Hearing no other comments, Chairman Hawkins closed the public hearing.

County Manager Bailes clarified that this project would have no effect on Eskridge Grove Baptist

Church.
